The Test of Interactive English (TIE) is an integrated four skills test of language proficiency. The qualifications each consist of two units in Speaking and Writing at each level, within which Reading and Listening skills are embedded.

The test has been designed for Candidates who are not native speakers of English and who wish to achieve a high quality, internationally recognised qualification in English that is available and recognised worldwide and at the highest level. It is suitable for Candidates who are preparing for entry to higher education or professional employment in the UK or elsewhere. The exam is designed to reference the descriptions of language proficiency in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). The levels in the CEFR have been mapped to the levels in the Regulated Qualifications Framework (RQF).

The Test of Interactive English qualifications assess the Candidate's competency in speaking, listening, reading and writing at each level. The four language skills are assessed interactively. In this way, the test reflects language as it naturally occurs in real life usage.

Assessment

Assessment comprises an evaluation of the Candidate's Interactive / Communicative Effectiveness, Visual / Aural Reception and Linguistic Competency (comprising of grammatical accuracy, lexical range and appropriacy, spelling and punctuation, text organisation and phonological control).

In order to achieve a Pass

TIE is an achievement test. Candidates may be awarded a qualification at the level they have entered at or be awarded a qualification at a lower or higher level of attainment. Candidates who do not fulfil the requirements of the lowest level of attainment in the examinations will not be awarded a qualification. At C2 level, exceptional performance at this level may lead to the grade of C2+.
